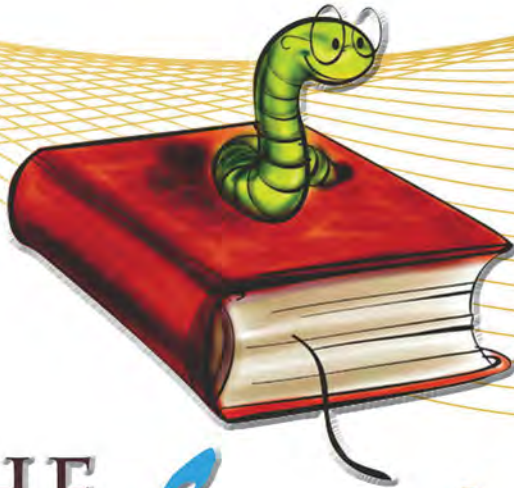

IN THE *spotlight* . . . GARY CHAPMAN



Dr. Gary Chapman seeks to fulfill his call to the ministry as a pastor, speaker, and author. His own life experiences, plus over thirty years of pastoring and marriage counseling, led him to publish his first book in **the Love Language series**, *The Five Love Languages: How to Express Heartfelt Commitment to Your Mate*. Millions of readers credit this continual bestseller with saving their marriages, by showing them simple and practical ways to communicate love to their partner. Sales exceeding 5 million copies earned him the Platinum Book Award from the Evangelical Publishers Association for *The Five Love Languages*, which has been translated into over thirty-six languages. Twenty-seven other books and five video series are among his publications.

Dr. Chapman speaks extensively throughout the U.S. and internationally on marriage, family, and relationships. His popular radio program, "A Love Language Minute," is heard on more than 100 radio stations across the U.S. He also serves as senior associate pastor at Calvary Baptist Church in Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

 Focus on . . . FICTION



Mindy Starns Clark is the bestselling author of the inspirational **Million Dollar Mysteries**, the **Smart Chick Mysteries**, the **Women of Lancaster County** series as well as standalone mysteries and nonfiction books. Mindy is also the author of numerous plays and musicals which have been performed in churches and schools across the country. She has written textbooks, articles, short stories, and more than 75 computer software manuals.

The following is a portion of an interview with Mindy by christianbook.com that gives insight into her work:

What message would you like your readers to take from *Trouble with Tulip*?

There are different messages coming from different characters. I would think number one would be Jo's own struggle. If you want to have intimacy with other people it really needs to start with intimacy with God. That's sort of the path she's going to have to be on now. She's obviously picking men for all the wrong reasons and I need her to find out why.

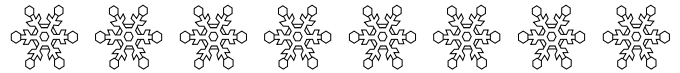


I was visiting with a lady this past summer and I mentioned that my new character was going to be someone who moved around a lot as a child. This lady's whole demeanor changed, she got very serious, and she said that if I really wanted to know what that was like, she would tell me, since she had been a military daughter. She ended up writing me about a four page letter describing what it was like to go from place to place throughout her childhood and never really connect with anyone. Her insights and honesty added so much dimension to Jo Tulip. Some things I kind of figured out on my own, others it would never have dawned on me-- for example, that for some people it can be very hard to find intimacy with God, because they put up a wall with everybody including Him.

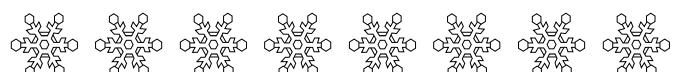
What is your goal or mission as a Christian writer?

You know, it started out as merely "to entertain." Originally, the choice to make my work Christian was more of a writer's choice; my faith is so important to me that I couldn't figure out how to tell a story without faith. But what I'm finding in the response from my readers is that just by telling my stories and putting faith into them, I am helping other people who may be struggling with how to live a Christian walk day-to-day. So now, my goal is "to convey through fiction the Christian walk: its struggles, its joys, its triumphs, and its rewards." I hope that every story I tell accomplishes that!

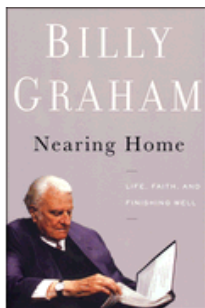

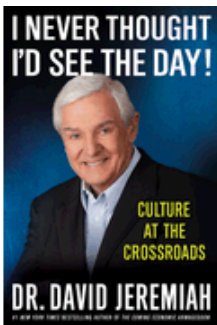

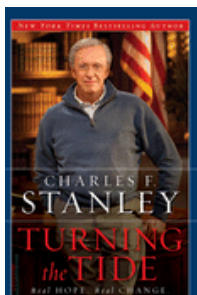

Amish Fiction



Warm bread, freshly baked shoofly pies, lush rolling hills, and handmade quilts are hallmarks of the Amish way of life. Amish fiction is one of the most popular circulation areas in the Liberty Library. Some of the favorite authors include Beverly Lewis, Shelley Shephard Gray, Wanda Brunstetter, Cindy Woodsmall, Suzanne Woods Fisher, Mary Ellis, Beth Wiseman, Amy Clipston, Kathleen Fuller, Kelly Long, Mindy Starns Clark, and Jerry Eicher.



The Library's collection is not limited to the printed page. A catalog search indicates 199 items which also include Books on CD and DVDs.

Award winning and popular author Beverly Lewis provides insight into the popularity of Amish fiction, **when asked**, "How does reading your books help readers understand such life-struggles, or, at least, how to cope with these trials?" Beverly responded, "I pray that my books are a help on various levels. For one thing, due to the character-driven nature of my novels, my "story people," in many ways, are searching for universal truths, just as readers are. My hope and prayer is that the books I write will offer a faith-based solution to the problems of the human condition. Each of us must deal with the problem of pain and suffering, trials and tests on some level through the span of our lives. My stories offer the hope of the Gospel, that there IS a compassionate, personal God who sees our dilemma, and He cares and understands—and no evil force can separate us from that kind of God-love. It is a true gift, unconditional and **available to anyone whose heart is open to divine truth.**"

Amish Haystack Dinner

from Mary Ellis, author of *A Widow's Hope*

This is often used by Old Order Amish for fundraising events or other community suppers, and is served "salad bar" style. You start at the beginning of the line and build your "haystack" with the items you enjoy, in the quantities you can handle. Guests donate what ever they can afford per plate at the end of the line.

From bottom to top:

1. crushed Ritz crackers
2. sloppy-joe seasoned meat
3. shredded cheese
4. chopped onions
5. diced tomatoes
6. chopped peppers
7. shredded lettuce
8. peas
9. your choice: melted cheese sauce OR sweet & sour salad dressing
10. optional: Doritos chips either for scooping or crushed for topping
11. optional: sour cream

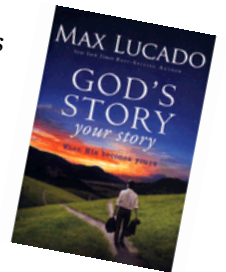


This dinner is usually served with dinner rolls/butter and with ice cream topped with chocolate syrup for dessert.

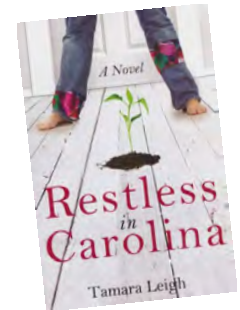
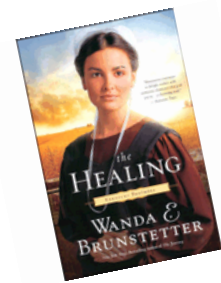
