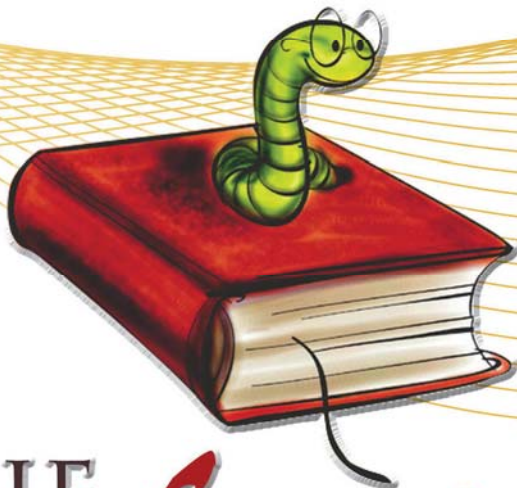

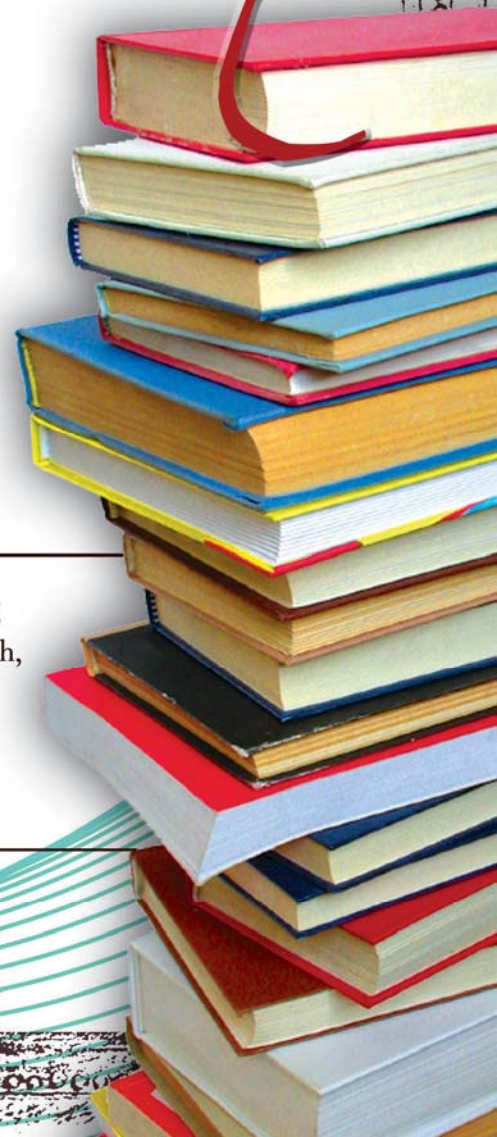

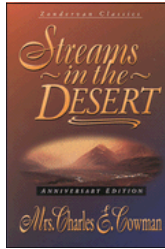


These books have inspired and are recommended by Liberty's Associate Pastor—College and Young Adults. Those marked with an asterik(*) are available in Liberty's Library .

Wiersbe Bible Commentary Old Testament and New Testament. Developed and abridged from Dr. Warren Wiersbe's popular "Be" series of Bible study books, these commentaries offer insights on the Old and New Testaments, with introductions and outlines for each book, and emphasize personal application as well as biblical meaning.

Christian Theology. Millard J. Erickson writes from a conservative, evangelical, and Baptist perspective. *Christian Theology* offers incredible depth of detail with meticulous analysis of the major issues in theology and is an indispensable tool for pastors, students and church leaders.

***Streams in the Desert.** Few books ever attain such a widespread recognition and perennial appeal as *Streams in the Desert*. Now over seventy years since its first publication, this marvelous devotional by Mrs. Charles E. Cowman has established itself firmly in the ranks of the Christian classics. Written from Mrs. Cowman's rich experiences in life, from its dry wastelands to its well-watered gardens, *Streams in the Desert* is a legacy of faith and wisdom that is time-tested faithfully to the One who alone can quench one's spiritual thirst.



The Heart of a Coach: Daily Devotions for Leading by Example. (Fellowship of Christian Athletes) *Heart of a Coach* is a daily devotional that provides 120 short but meaningful readings using realistic coaching situations to help coaches understand the truth and relevancy of the Bible to everyday life. It will bring insight into handling life's daily challenges and enable a coach to use biblical principles to teach and motivate athletes.

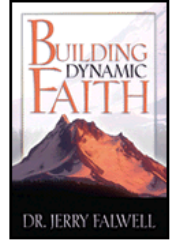
Strength for the Journey: Day by Day with Jesus. The Christian life is filled with mountaintops and valleys, and often we find ourselves praying for the endurance just to keep going. Joseph W. Stowell brings you back to Jesus each day, providing nourishment for your faith and refreshment for your spirit in 365 scripture meditations that help you focus on joy, perseverance, righteousness, healing, prayer, and more.

Morning and Evening Devotions. Charles Spurgeon's uplifting messages will comfort and refresh you in your walk with God. Spending time with God at the start and the close of each day will bring a new joy to your life. As you reflect upon God's Word and His principles, you will find peace about the day you are about to face or the day that has just passed. Spurgeon's rich biblical insights, extraordinary eloquence, and clarity of logic are interwoven throughout the daily selections to enhance your fellowship with God.

The Bible Promise Book. (Barbour Publishing) Whatever the need of the moment, the answer can be found in God's Word. *The Bible Promise Book*, a perennial best-seller, includes over one thousand promises from the Bible, arranged alphabetically by topic and gives quick and easy access to God's truth.

***Building Dynamic Faith.**

Using inspirational examples on faith as illustrated by the life and faith of Dr. Jerry Falwell, *Building Dynamic Faith* invites readers to experience the changing power of faith in their own lives. The reader will progress from a simple understanding of faith, to having practiced the skills needed to exercise faith, and finally, to having experienced the blessing of God through answered prayer.



It's Time to Be Bold. Popular Christian musician Michael W. Smith reflects on the spiritual lessons of his performing career, urging believers to strengthen their own faith by becoming active witnesses for the Christian life. He discusses the importance of cultivating Christian friendships, prayer, and scriptural study in terms of his own personal growth through faith in Jesus.

***Women's Evangelical Commentary: Old Testament and New Testament.** (Rhonda Kelley and Dorothy Patterson) Dalton's wife, Lindsay Beth, recommends these commentaries written and edited by women for women. While some commentaries take an egalitarian view of the relationship between men and women, these writers believe the complementarian view of the relationship between men and women most accurately interprets God's intent as expressed in scripture. This view is often caricatured and greatly distorted by both the secular media and some church leaders. The Woman's Evangelical Commentary will enable readers to move beyond those caricatures and see God's marvelous design and plan for men and women.

A note from author **RANDY ALCORN** about the novelization of *Courageous*



Some movie screenplays are based on novels; others are written directly for the movie. In those cases, a novelist, such as myself, is called in to do a "novelization" of the screenplay, as is the case with "Courageous." The fun thing about this project for me is that the excellent spine of the novel "Courageous" already exists in the screenplay, but the novel is over four times longer, meaning that as a novelist I had to invent 80% of the story line. This is an exciting process, because I am free to use my imagination and introduce new characters and locations and many scenes that are not in the movie. I was determined to remain true to the movie, so that while the novel goes behind and beyond the movie, at the same time it never contradicts it. The movie opened September 30, 2011.

Many who watch the movie "Courageous" will want to learn more about the story than what is in the two hours. The novel is the equivalent of ten hours of screen time, and allows much more exploration of the characters, back-story, and subplots as well as new dramatic scenes (without having to spend millions of dollars to produce them).

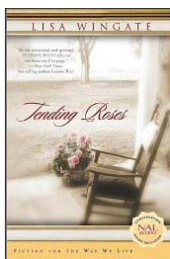
LISA WINGATE

Lisa Wingate is an award-winning journalist, magazine columnist, popular inspirational speaker and a national bestselling author of 16 books. Her first mainstream novel, *Tending Roses*, is in its fifteenth printing from Penguin Putnam. *Tending Roses* is a staple on the shelves of national bookstore chains as well as in many independent bookstores.



Recently, Lisa's Blue Sky Hill Series, set in Dallas, received national attention with back-to-back nominations for American Christian Fiction Writers Book of the Year Award for *A Month of Summer* (2009) and *The Summer Kitchen* (2010). Pithy, emotional, and inspirational, her stories bring to life characters so real that readers often write to ask what is happening to them after the book ends.

Lisa is one of a select group of authors to find success in both the Christian and mainstream markets, writing for both Bethany House, a Christian publisher, and NAL Penguin Putnam, in mainstream fiction. Her bestselling books have become a hallmark of inspirational southern fiction. Her works have been featured by the National Reader's Club of America, AOL Book Picks, Doubleday Book Club, the Literary Guild, American Profiles and have been chosen for numerous awards.



When not busy dreaming up stories, Lisa spends time on the road as a motivational speaker. Via internet, she shares with readers as far away as India, where her book, *Tending Roses*, has been used to promote women's literacy, and as close to home as Tulsa, Oklahoma, where the county library system has used *Tending Roses* to help volunteer mentors teach adults to read.

Recently, the group Americans for More Civility, a kindness watchdog organization, selected Lisa along with Bill Ford, Camille Cosby, and six others, as recipients of the National Civics Award, which celebrates public figures who work to promote greater kindness and civility in American life.

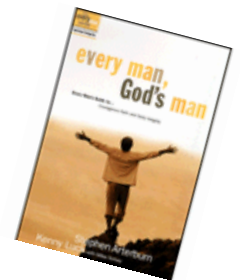
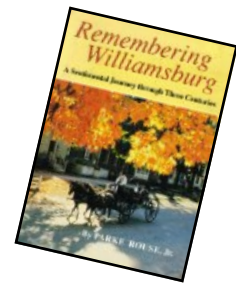

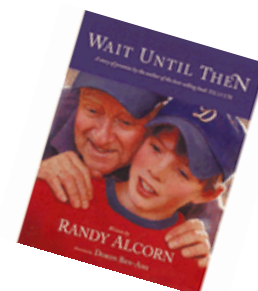
